

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF THE OVEN AND BURNING

When use oven or fireplace, agree with the staff and use prepared firewood. The use of other fuels or toxic substances is prohibited. For environmental reasons, do not burn waste, especially plastics. The burning of flammable liquids (eg petrol) and explosive substances (eg pressurized packaging) is prohibited.

Conditions for use determined in document information for guests.

IGNITION

Open the air control dampers before lighting. To set the appropriate air pressure, find the primary air regulator on the ash removal door and the secondary regulator on the fuel loading door. Place paper on the racks, then a slice or thin wood, followed by thicker wood. After ignition, close the fuel loading door and the ash removal door. Then place one piece of thicker wood on the fire.

OPERATION

After forming the first embers and a small flame, load further wood. Never load more than two pieces of wood. Make sure that the stove is heated with a steady low heat at the first heating, not with a hasty one.

To ensure an adequate amount of primary air, the grilles should be well shaken, and the ash removed before each refueling. Clean the ash pan regularly. The door must be closed during operation. Only open the fireplace door while refueling!

STOPPING THE DEVICE AND CLEANING

Remove the ash from the grate and the pan from the already cooled oven. Close the door and the air regulator. Do not clean the ash and especially the embers with plastic bins, but only with the iron spatulas next to the stove. Do not place the ashes in a container, but in a specially marked place next to the container (agreement with the staff!)

In case of any problems, contact the staff immediately, who will be happy to help you.

The stove must not be overturned, or laundry dried on them, due to the high risk of ignition!
